About the Survey...

This survey is a regular quarterly sounding of constituent provincial voters across Canada concerning the approval of their Provincial Premier. For this particular series dating back to 2013, the following question has been asked of the incumbent Premier:

Do you approve or disapprove of the performance of...[strongly/moderately/not sure]

Because of extremely small sample sizes, approval ratings cannot be provided for Prince Edward Island, Nunavut and both the Yukon and Northwest Territories.

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Methodology...

These are some of the topline findings of a **DART C-Suite Communicators maru/Blue Voice Canada Poll** conducted as part of a regular quarterly sounding of Canadians on various issues and matters that affect their lives as citizens, consumers, and voters. The research is created and analyzed under the direction of veteran pollster John Wright, who is a Partner of **DART C-Suite Communicators**. Data was collected by Canada's national survey sample research provider **maru/Blue** using their Omni Online curated panel.

The survey was conducted among 5,155 randomly selected Canadian adults who are members of **maru/Blue's** Online panel between February 27 to March 6, 2020. Respondents could opt in for either official language. The results have been weighted by education, age, gender, and region to match the population, according to Census data. This is to ensure the sample is representative of the entire adult population of Canada. Reporting of results from Prince Edward Island, Nunavut and both the Yukon and Northwest Territories is excluded because of extremely small sample sizes. Discrepancies in or between totals are due to rounding. The precision of this **DART C-Suite Communicators maru/Blue Voice Canada Poll** is measured using a Bayesian Credibility Interval. In this case, the poll is accurate to within +/- 1.6 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, had all Canadian adults been polled. The credibility interval will be wider among subsets of the population and individual provinces.

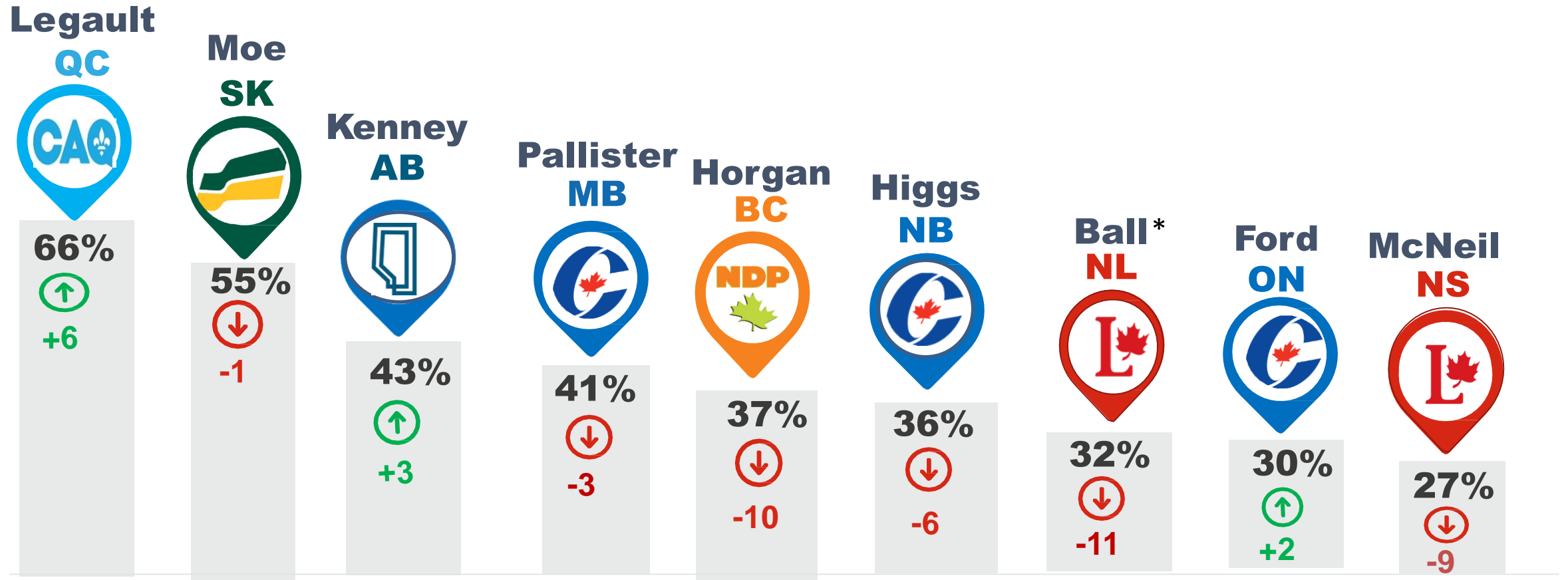

Canadian Premiers' Approval Ratings at a Glance March 2020

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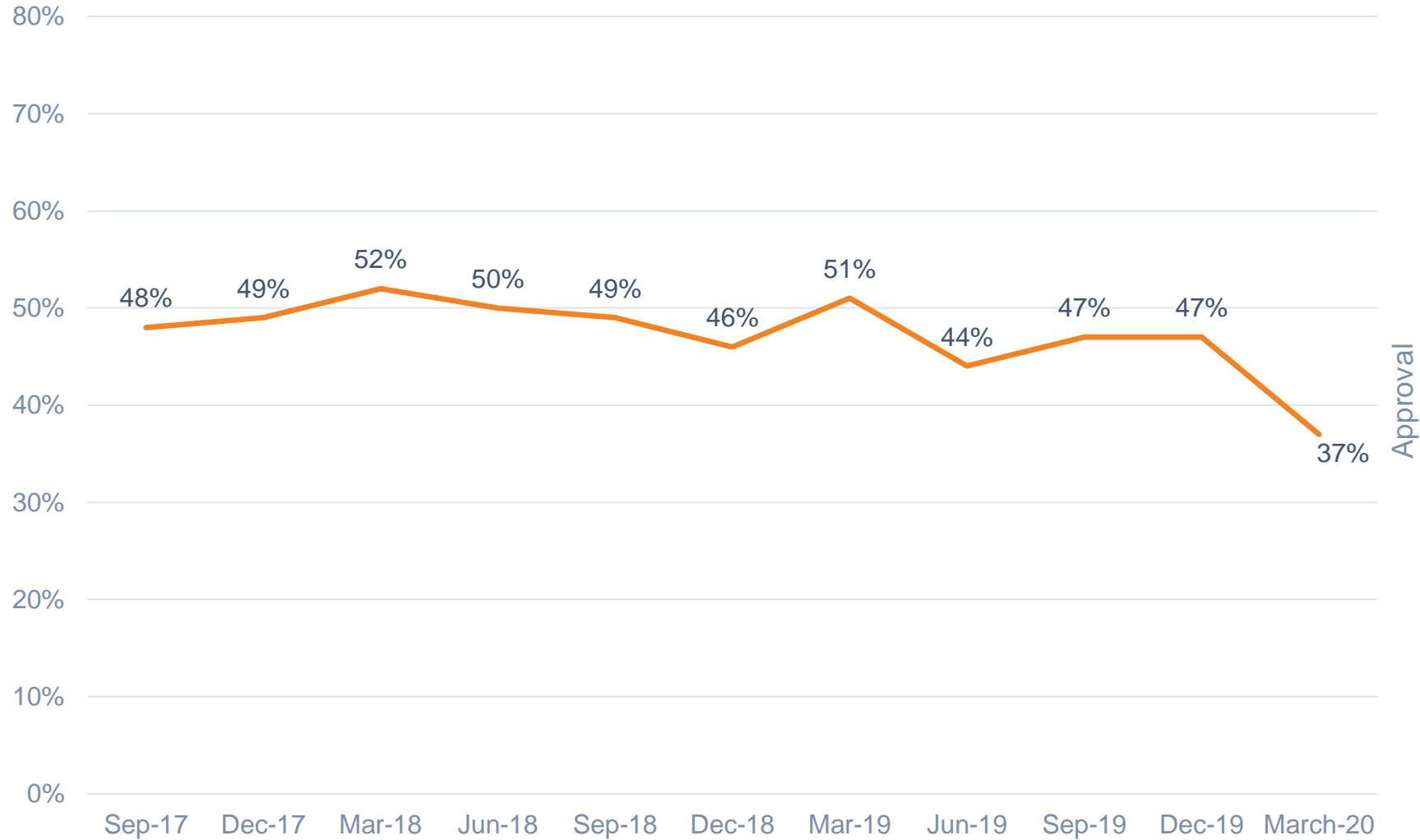

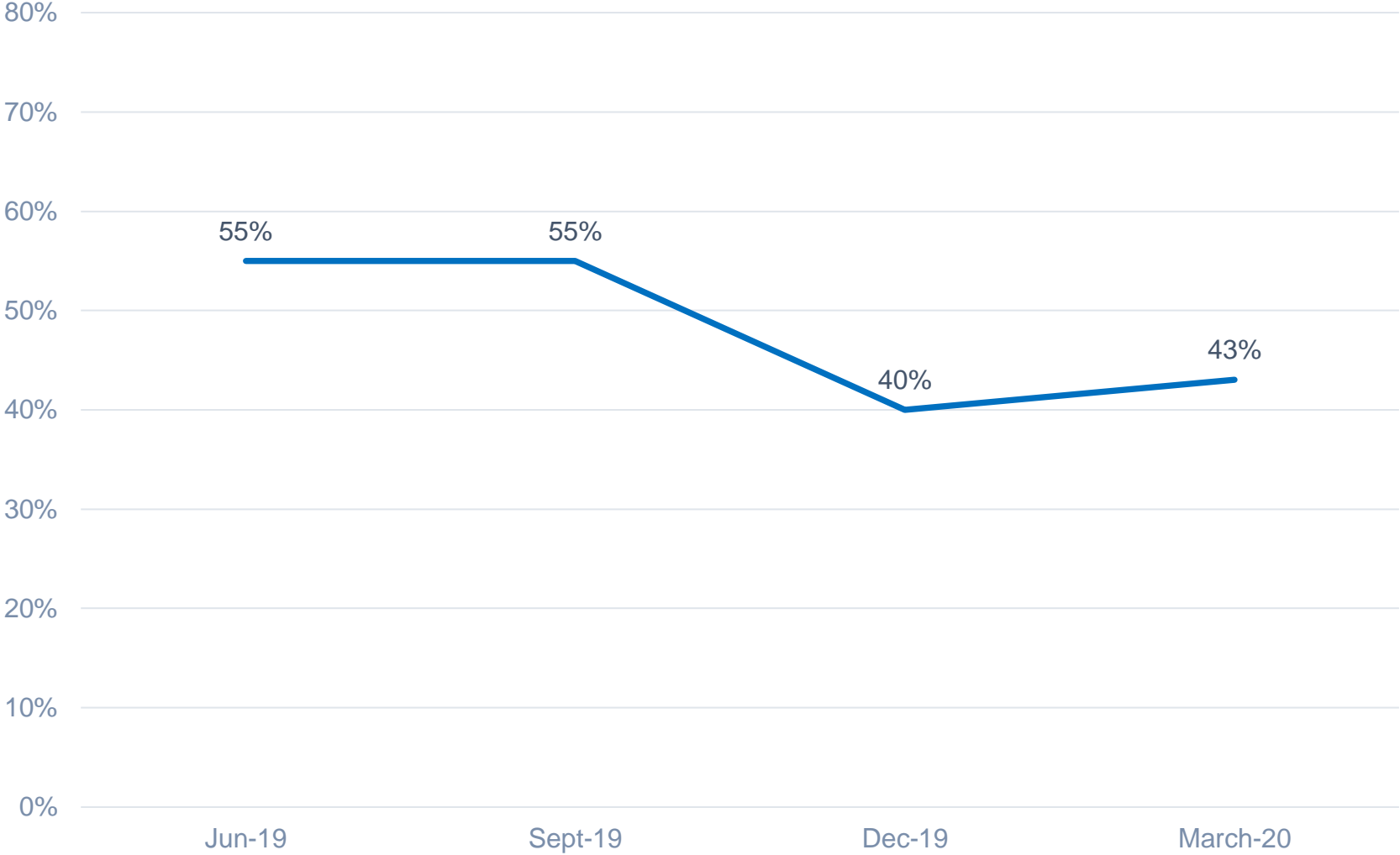

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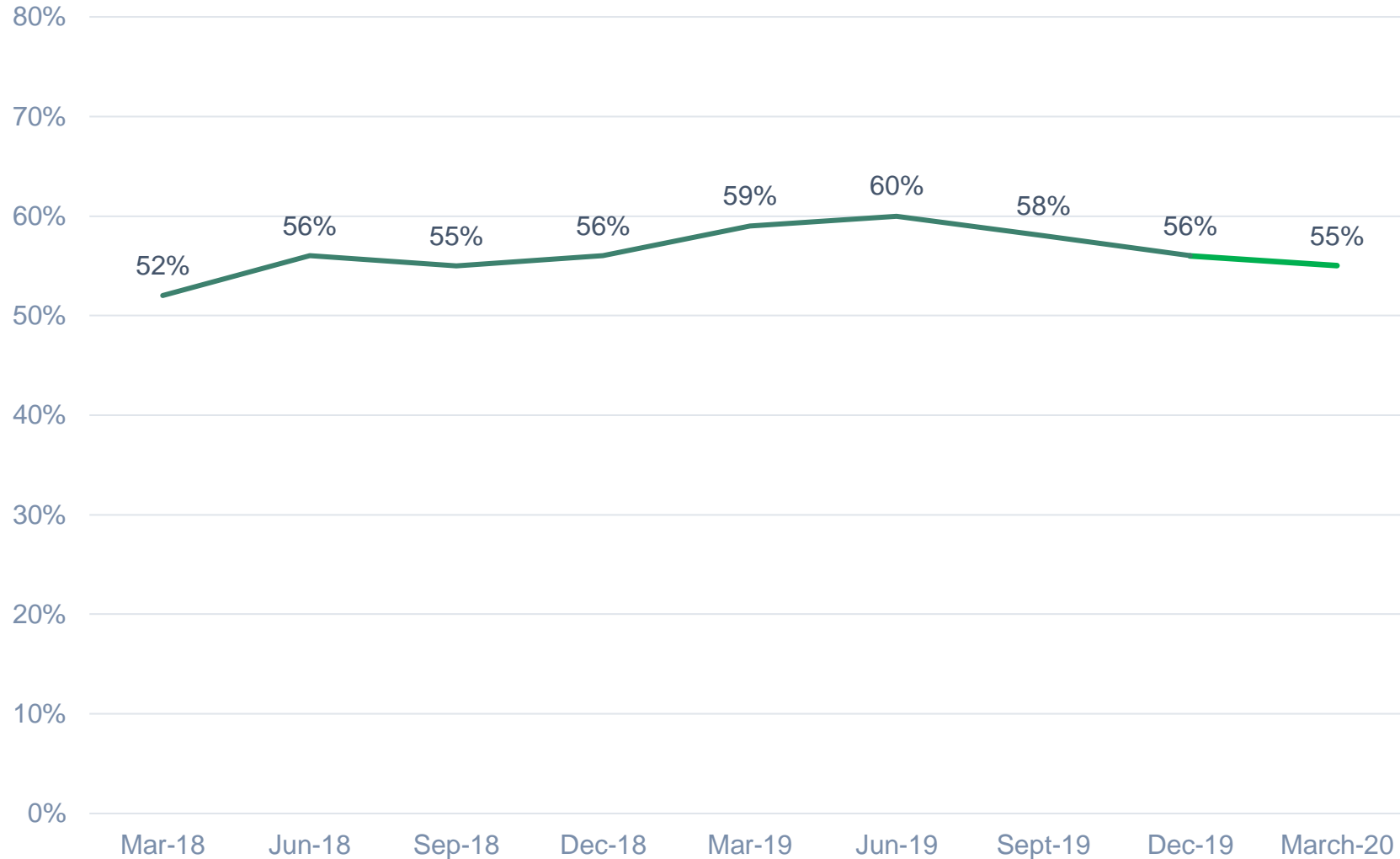

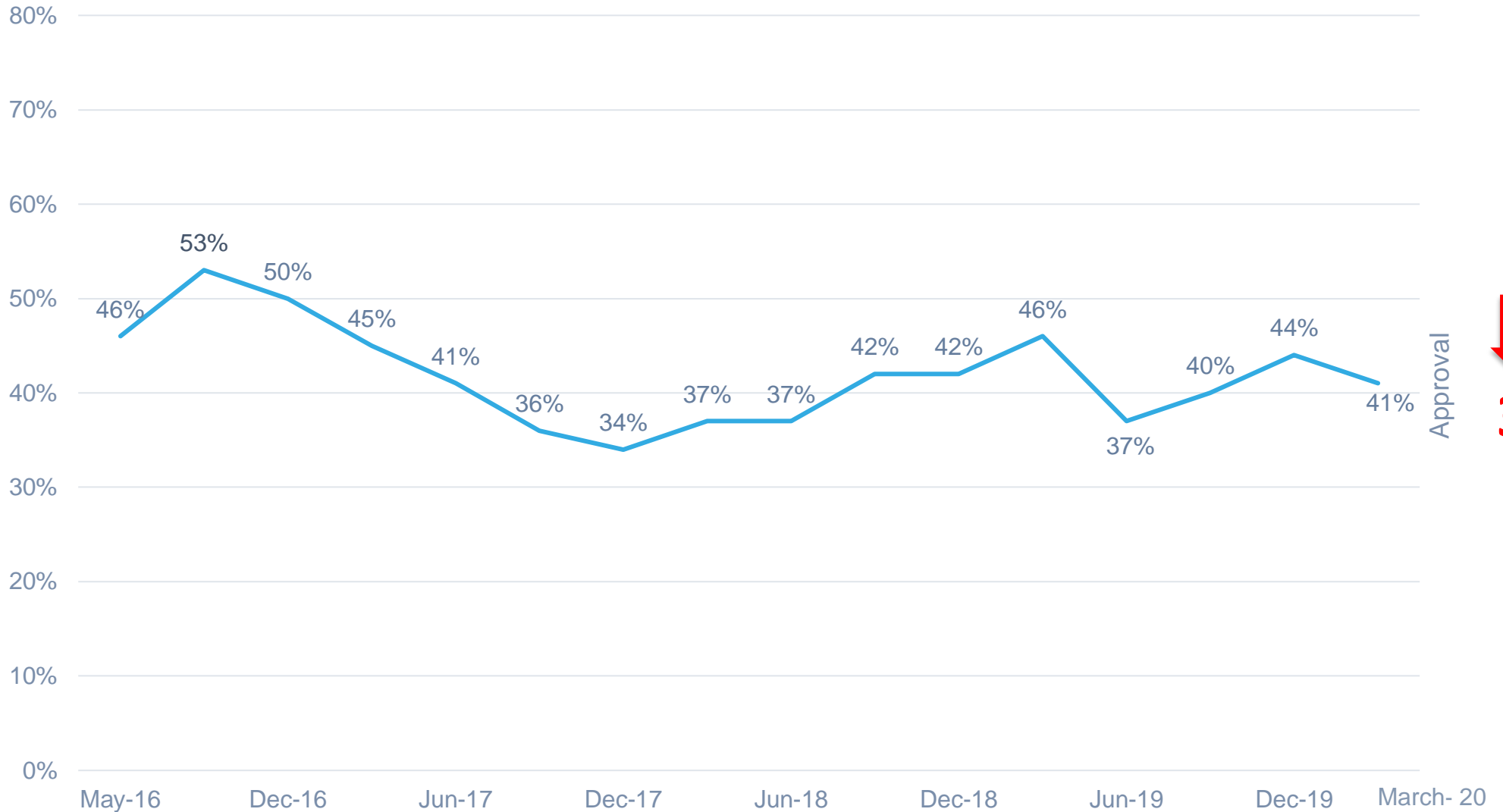

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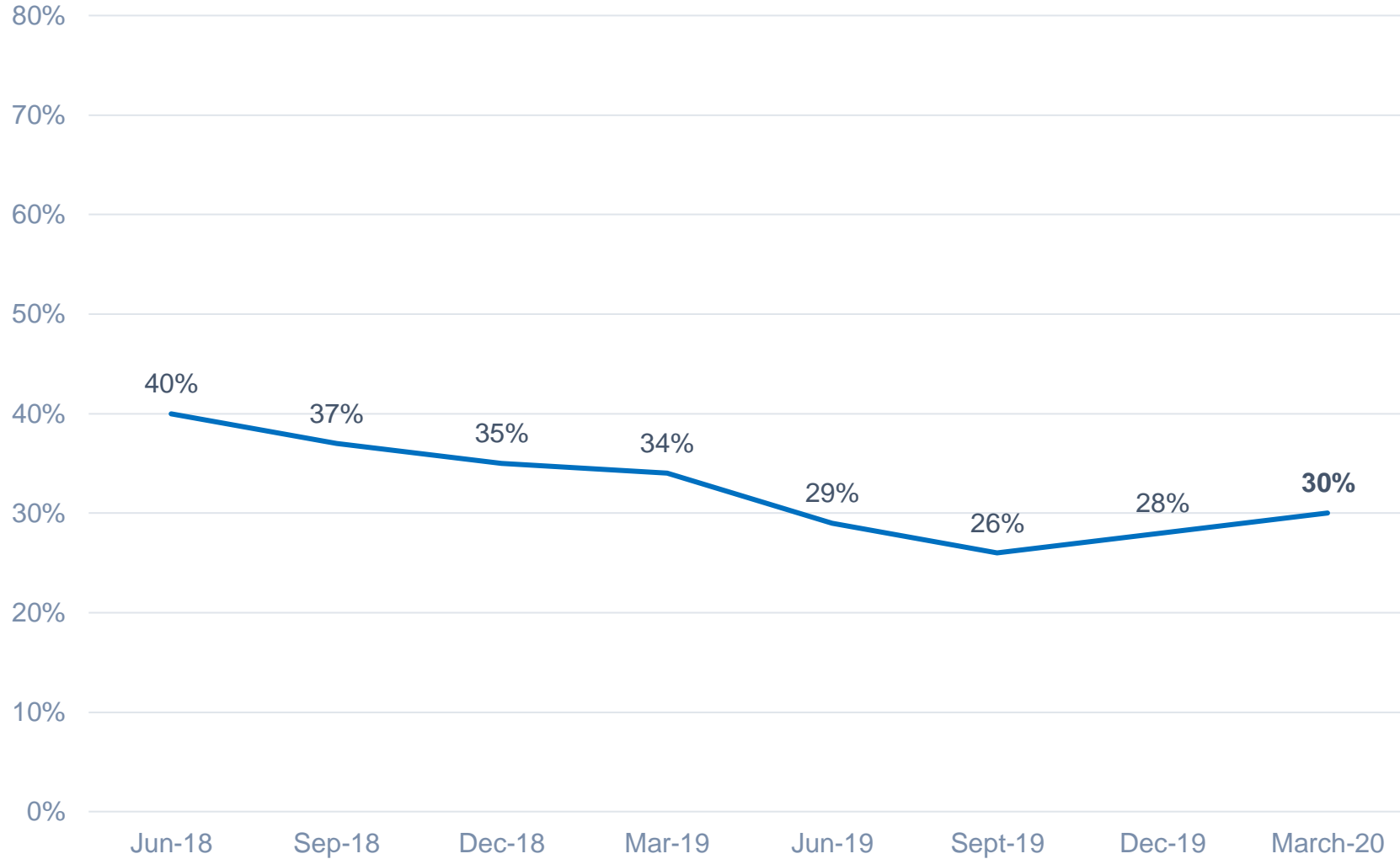

Canadian Premier Approval Ratings Q1 March 2020

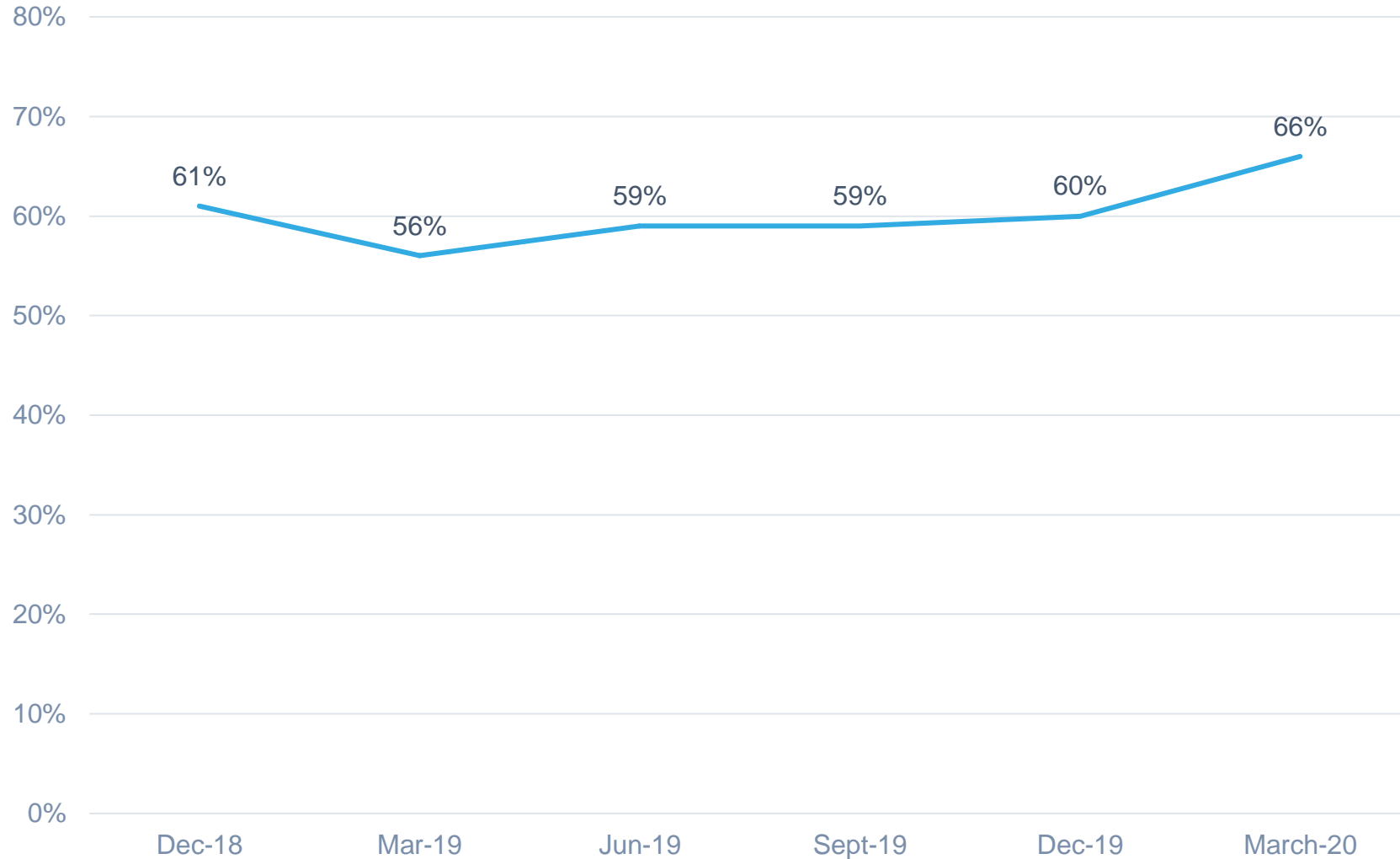

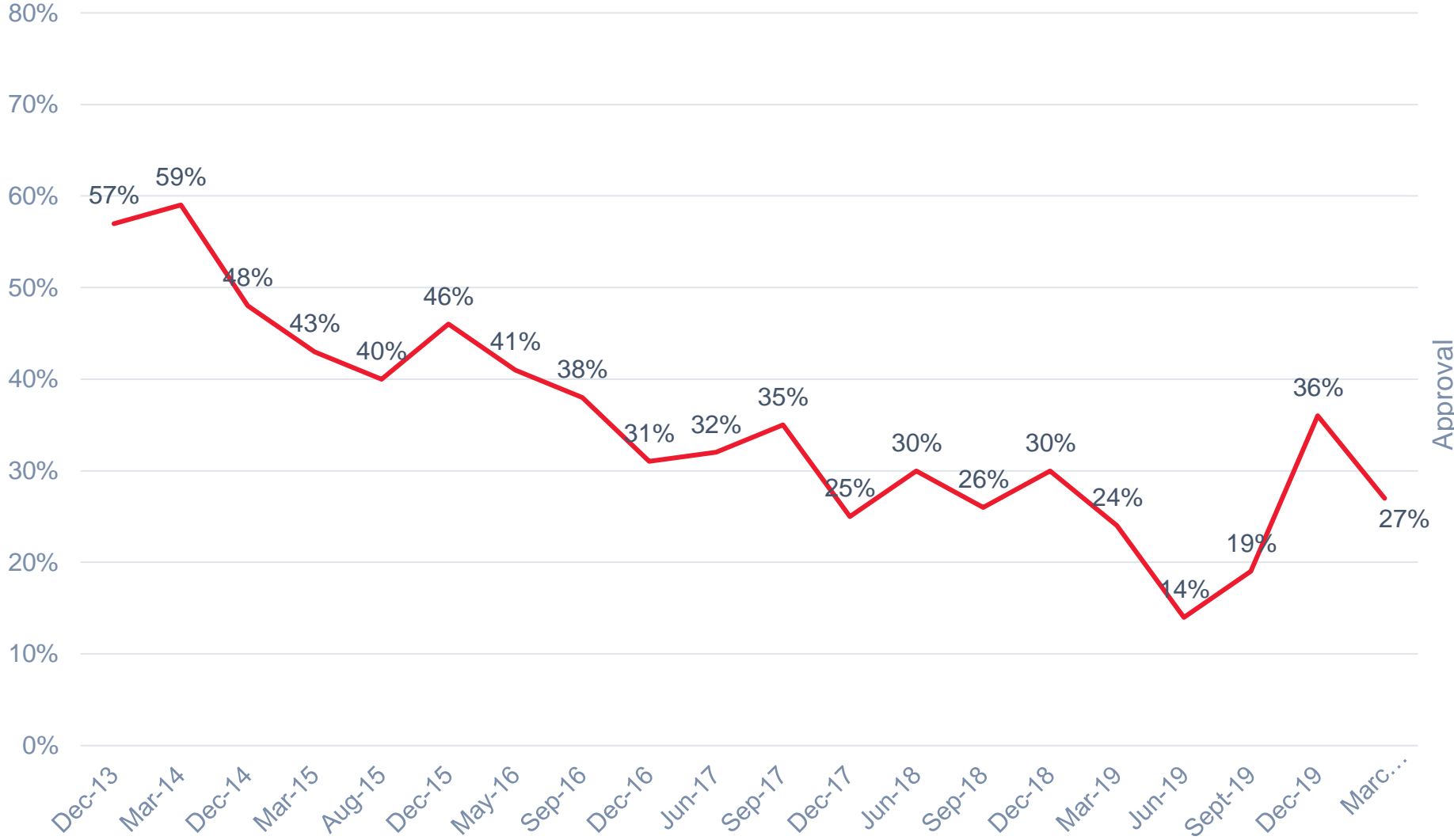

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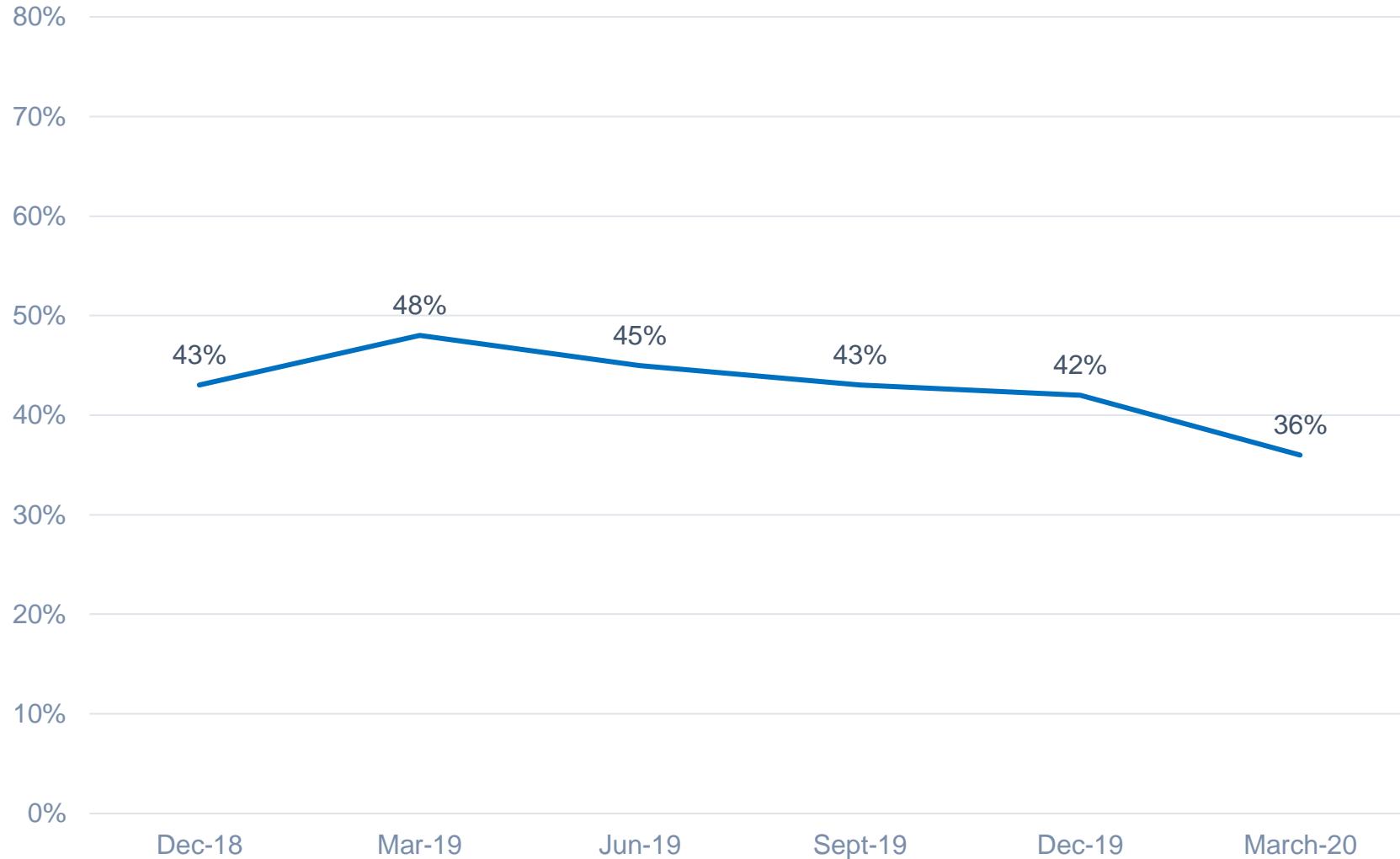

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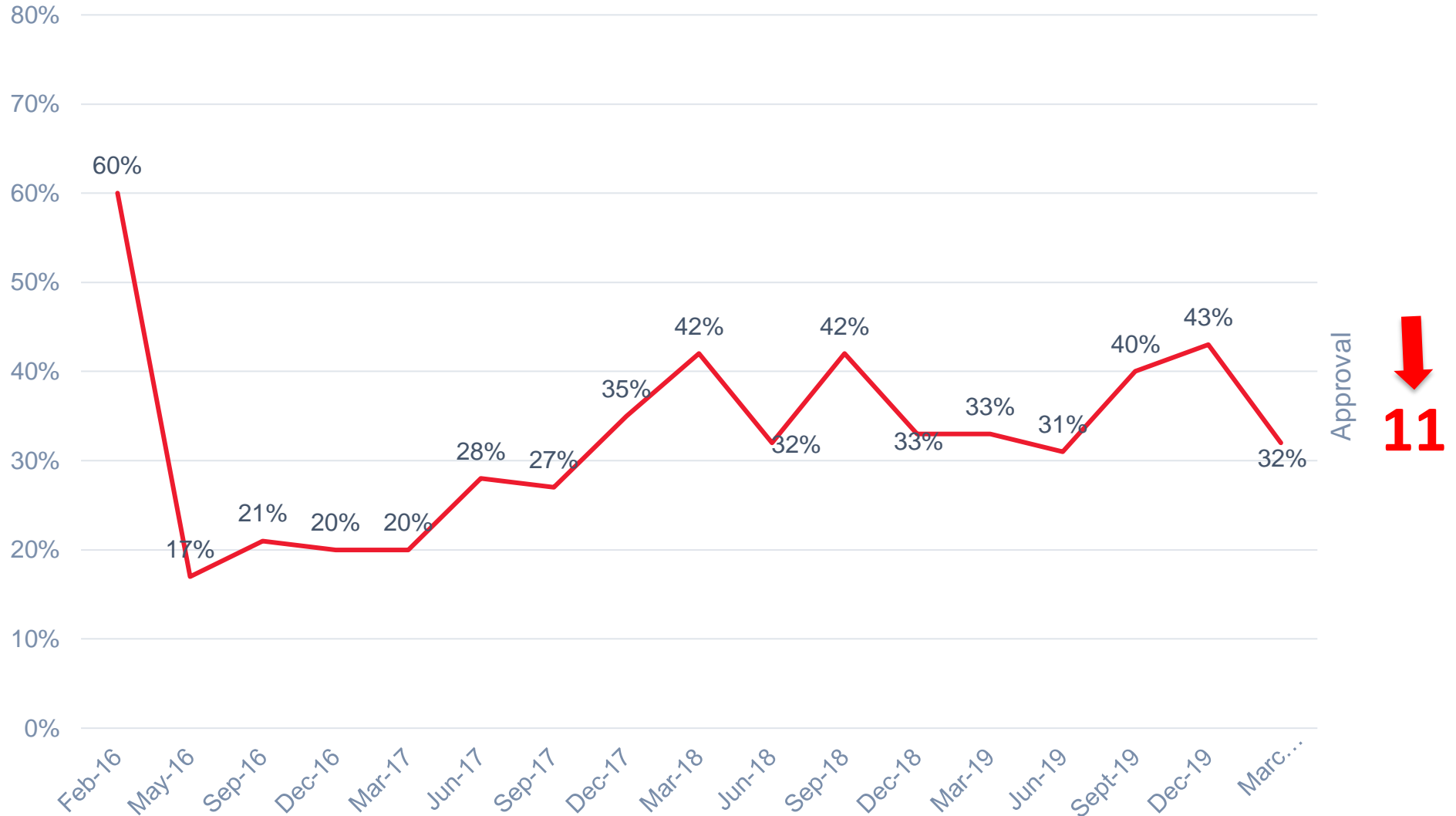
